### **NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE WORKS M1 Junction 23 to Junction 23a**

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential maintenance work on the M1 between junction 23 and junction 23a, on both the northbound and southbound carriageways.

During our scheme we will:

- carry out patching repair works to both carriageways
- reinstate road markings and traffic loops
- remove and replace the waterproofing layer on the West Meadow Viaduct

Once completed, drivers will benefit from improved road safety and a smoother journey.

#### **When will the work take place?**

Work is due to start on **23 September 2019** and is scheduled for completion by the end of **October 2019**. To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and minimise disruption to the local community and road users, we will work:

- between 9pm and 5am, Saturday to Thursday (northbound carriageway)
- between 10pm and 6am, Monday to Saturday\* (southbound carriageway)

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances and \*some Sunday shifts may be required.

#### **How will the work affect traffic?**

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and customers, we will need to close the M1 between junction 23 and junction 23a while we work. We will only close one carriageway at a time.

Both carriageways will be open as usual outside our working hours on weekdays. When we work during a weekend, a single lane closure will remain in place during the daytime, for safety reasons.

During our road closures we will put in place fully signed diversion routes which have been agreed with the Local Authority. Please refer to the attached drawing for further detailed information.


We politely ask all heavy vehicles to follow the M1 diversion route which will help minimise the overnight disturbance experienced by communities in the surrounding area.
